Activities We will pack the days and evenings with meaningful events that will impact the lives of youth and adults alike as we participate together in events and learn together in Chapel services the incredible love God has for us. Camp Registration Fee is kept at a minimum (\$50) this year because our camp has pursued fund raising among the community. Your Registration Fee will cover all activities, a Heart O' Texas T-Shirt, overnight floor space, meals and snacks. Doors will open for camper check-in at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, June 3.

Parental Approval is necessary for children 18 and under so please include the Medical Release and Parental Permission Form with the Application Form. Also please sign the Photo Release on the Application Form, giving permission for photo or video release, as photos and videos of campers may be used in publications of Heart O' Texas camp, Generations Ministries and Grace Communion International.

Catered Meals will be served during the camp, beginning with evening meal on Friday night. Some of the meals will consist of meals donated by area businesses. We will provide some snacks and refreshments at various times of the day.

Overnight Lock-In Friday and Saturday night will consist of a lock-in at the Church Building. Games and activities will be available for all ages. Separate sleeping quarters will be provided for males and females with adult supervision. Each person should bring sufficient bedroll for comfortable sleeping on the floor. Separate bathroom facilities are available, although there are presently no showers in the building.

Church Services Our final activity will be special church services in Hope Community Fellowship on Sunday morning at 11:00 AM. Everyone, including staff members, campers and their parents are welcome to join us for Worship Services at 11:00 AM.
